#### 8. PERSONNEL DIRECTOR:

Ms. Clark highlighted the following items:

- Since July 1, 2022, the Commission staff has filled 111 classified and unclassified positions. She acknowledged Beth Peterson, Valeria Martinez and other staff for their efforts in hiring staff for the start of the new school year. There are an additional 45 positions that have been offered and are in the process of being cleared and hired.
- Twenty-six eligibility lists have been certified as of today. The volume of work produced by this office is incredible.
- The District has added several classified positions to support the increase in Early Learning Programs in the areas of Preschool, Transitional Kindergarten and Kindergarten.
- The District has permanently increased the hours for all Health Assistants to seven (7).

Ms. Meyer inquired about the new Pre-Kindergarten position and Ms. Clark explained that these were new Early Childhood positions, which encompassed the regular Preschool (10 or 12 months), the Expanded Learning Opportunities for Preschool and the Transitional Kindergarten mentioned above.
