How Sjogren's syndrome affects oral health**



Dry mouth is one of the most common symptoms of Sjogren's syndrome and can lead to mouth sores, gum disease and tooth decay if it's not addressed early.



ORAL SENSITIVITY

Sjogren's syndrome makes it harder to chew certain foods and more uncomfortable to brush. But it's important to maintain oral hygiene to counteract the lack of protection from decreased saliva.



THRUSH

Since Sjogren's syndrome is an autoimmune disease, it can disrupt the balance of microorganisms in the mouth and lead to a yeast infection. Stay on top of thrush to prevent it from spreading to other parts of the body.

How the reimbursement process works

1. Enroll

To get reimbursed, you first have to enroll in the Cigna Dental Oral Health Integration Program[®] by either:

- Going to myCigna.com, selecting Coverage > Dental and filling out the registration form online
- Calling the number on the back of your Cigna ID card and asking for a mailed registration form

2. Submit your claim

Go to your dentist and pay the copay or coinsurance for the covered treatment. If your dentist is in the Cigna network, they'll send us a claim for reimbursement. If your dentist isn't in the Cigna network, you might need to submit the claim. We'll review the claim and mail full reimbursements for covered treatments in about 30 days.
